

If this Paper of Particulars and the Certificates connected with it, be not sent in original, the copies must be duly attested.

- Head I or Paige. In the case of an Officer serving on the West Coast of Africa, a statement is to be added whether he is a rative of that Coast. (Colomal Regulations, § 430).
- HEAR 3.—State the description of Allowance for which the Applicant is recommended, viz., Superannuation, Compassionate Allowance, or Gratuity, and its amount. In the case of Person claiming an addition to their Pensons in respect of Professional or other special qualifications, this should be stated, and a reference should be given to the authority under which the claim is made.
- Heap 5c off the service has been interrupted by one or more breaks, the word "broken" should be added before or after a number of years and months, and the causes, dates, and gircumstances of the break or breaks should be stated under heading 9.
- From 6 off the Person retiring has been in receipt of the same Salary, or in the class from which he retires for the 36 months immediately before the date of his retirement, the actual annual rate of Salary or Wages at that date should be inserted, preceded by the wood "actual."
