

If this Paper of Particulars and the Certificates connected with it, be not see in original, the copies must be duly attested.

- Head I or Paper.—In the case of an Officer serving on the West Coast of Africa, a statement is to be added whether he is a native of that Coast. (Colonial Regulations, § 430).
- Head 3.—State the description of Allowadee for which the Applicant is recommended, etc. Supersumulation, Compensation, Compensation, Compensation and Allowance, or Gratality, and its amount. In the case of Persons claiming an addition to their Pensions for expect of Professional or other precisi quantifications, this should be stated, and a reference about the given to the authority under which the claim is made.
- HEAD 5.—If the service has been interrupted by one or more breaks, the serif "broken" should be added before or after the number of years and mouths, and the causes, dates, and circumstances of the break or breaks should be stated under heading 9.
