Bairobi Electric Fower and Lighting Concession.

Sir,

With reference to your letter No.62582/1920 of the 24th December, and to our semi-efficial communication of the 36th December, I have the honour to report that the licence to assign the above Concession to Mr. Charles Udall has been duly executed and forwarded to the Schloitors to the Nairobi Electric Power and Lighting Company Limited. Two copies of the completed document are enclosed herewith, and the draft forwarded with your letter under reference is returned as requested.

2. I take the opportunity to enquire, with reference to your letter \$0.39424/17 of the 11th August 1917 and previous correspondence, whether the negotiations in connection with the proposed area ment of the Concession have been shandoned.

TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME THE CROWN AGENTS for the COLONIES (hereinafter referred to as "the Crown Agents") acting for and on behalf of the Governor of Kenya (late East Africa Protectorate) SEND GREBTING WHEREAS DY an Agreement dated the 26th of July 1906 made between the Crown Agents acting as aforesaid of the one part and Clement Rirtzel therein described of the other part cernain rights and liberties were conceded to the said Clement Hirtzel in connection with certain covenants entered into by him to provide and supply electricity in the District of Mairobi in the Rast Africa Protestorate AND WHEREAS by an Indenture dated the and day of April 1909 the said Clement Hirtzel with the consent of the Crown Agents transferred the hereinbefore recited Agreement to the Nairobi Electric Power & Lighting Company Limited AND WHEREAS the Nairobi Electric Power & Lighting Company Limited has applied t the Crown Agents for leave and licence to assign the said Agreement to Charles Utall of Wiarobi Kenya Colony Africa AND WHEREAS by Clause 18 of the said Contract it is provided that the Nairobi Blectric Power & Lighting Company Limited shall not assign sublet transf or otherwise dispose of the said Contract or any interest therein or any powers conferred thereby withou the previous corsent in writing of His Majesty's Commissioner for the Mast Africa Protectorate or the Crown Agents on his behalf NOW THEREPORE KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the Crown Agents DO HEREBY CONSENT to such assignment or transfer as aforesaid

PROVIDED ALWAYS that this Consent shall not authorise any further assignment or transfer AND PROVIDED ALSO that this Consent shall in no vice release the said Clement Hirtzel from any of his covenants or liabilities under the said Contract or in connection therewith but that he shall be and remain primarily liable therefor.
