I am directed to forward for your information the following extract from a letter received from the B.E.A. Fibre & Industrial Company, on the subject of the proposed erection of a dam on the Kibwesi River by the authorities of the Uganda Railway:

"It has been brought to our notice that a "Survey Party has been sent up the Kibwesi River "for the purpose of taking levels for a projected pipe line to supply the engines of the Uganda Railway with water. It is the inan mode of pipe in the supply the supply from the Kibwesi River, that if any attempt is made to dam the Kibwesi River the result will be that it will disappear in the lawa, because the water, instead of being held back by the dam and stoned up, will "flow inrough the lawa on either side until it "reaches a water carrying strata, when it will then spread over the countryside, thus causing practically the loss of the whole of the Kibwesi "River."

"This opinion is submitted by those who "have intimate knowledge of the district, and is "undoubtedly correct, in fact, it is held that, if "the Kibwezi River is interfered with in any way, "its fate will be the same as the Masongaleni River
