Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter No. 59717/1921 of the 6th instant and to convey the thanks of my Directors for the action taken, mentioned therein.

In view of the direct bearing which a sale of my Company's undertaking would have upon the matters outstanding between Government and ourselves, we think it only right that we should inform you as to the present position, so far as we know it, in regard to such a possibility.

Briefly this may be summarized in stating that we are in negotiation with Mr. Udall with a view to finding some mutually agreeable method of arranging a fixed sale price in order to obviate the necessity of detail accounting in regard to the period which has elapsed since the matter was first mooted, but that at the same time we have informed him that we are still agreeable to sell him the undertaking upon the terms set out in the agreement for this purpose which we signed and sent out to Kenya in December 1920, adjusted as necessary for dates and to secure of course that any profits
