

With reference to our conversation of today's date re, Land Office letter No.C.19 AL/RM. of 24th December 1919, and your letter No.127 20 of the January 1920, we show estern it a favour if you could see your way to granting us an extension definitely stated to be of 18 months from date of ratification of peace in place of the extension as expressed in the above mentioned letters. The gist of these letters and the terms we hereby ask for are the same, but in the case of the two letters there is some idenable ambiguity, also these two letters emanate from different departments.

This has given rise to difficulties in the negotiations we are engaged in with regard to the financing of the undertaking. The above proposed alteration should be embedded in clause I of the draft agreement stating that the period allowed to the commessions iros be extended to 20th July 1921, or for 13 menths from the date of the official Ratification of Peace.

Owing to the present financial situation in England and the uncoelidable delays eccasioned by strikes, shipping difficulties ato, etc., every extra day available for impatigations ato is of enermous value. is of anormous value.
