CONVENTION OF ASSOCIATIONS.

European Community Kenya voiced by all unofficial Members Legislative Council here Convention Associations Farmers meetings through Colony. Soldier settler representatives and mass meetings held Nairobi yesterday confirm Convention telegram June 30th. Also same mass meeting Nairobi resolved proposed General Burney seconded Colonel Kortimer Durand that this meeting considers statement Lord Milner then Secretary for Colonies on 1st May 1960 constituted pledge and definition past and future permanent policy and that introduction of Soldier settlers was taken by them and by whole community to be guarantee this policy maintained and that Highlands would remain for ever European settlement under European administration. Also same meeting resolved proposed Dr. Burkitt seconded MacLellan Wilson spoken to and supported Bishop of Colony and ^{Members} Canyon Burns that not for good of native spiritually morally intellectually physically or materially if Government Kenya controlled by Indians. ² Furnish copies resolutions through Northey officially to Churchill also Cranworth, Macmillan, Grogan, Rodwell. ³ See and reply to code telegram to Grogan.
