Major Walsh has increased his intention to retire in 1923. No 394 of 1920 / 1921 and a new post of Sahr Asst has been created. Walsh's pay is £1070 and Kiracopp's is £800. Major's retirement at £900 in 1920-21 scale.

If the proposals in this tel. are approved Mr. Walsh goes up £200 a year to perform duties which the Gov. considered were grossly underpaid when Mr. Major performed them at £800 in 1920-21 scale.
