My Lord Duke,

In reply to Mr. Churchill's despatch No. 1305 of the 6th September, I have the honour to refer Your Grace to the representations made in my despatch No. 1606 of the 22nd November, which apply equally to the Unallocated Stores held by the Uganda Railway.

2. The residuum of the currency inflation prevailing in the case of these stores on the 1st April, 1921, has been assessed at £41,602, but pending receipt of Your Grace's views I am reluctant to issue a Special Warrant for the purpose of writing down these stores and prefer to await your telegraphic decision after perusal of the arguments adduced in support of the action taken with regard to the Unallocated Stores of the Public Works Department.

3. I shall be glad to receive Your Grace's instructions at the earliest opportunity.
