

I have the honour to refer to my despatch No. 1774 of the 18th December, 1921, containing an application by Mrs. G. W. Evans for a pension for herself and allowances for her children, and to enquire whether circumstances allow of an early reply, if possible by telegram.

2. I trust that the Ministry of Pensions will be disposed to accede to the request. Mrs. Evans is endeavouring to support herself and her children by keeping a boarding house but I am credibly informed that she is suffering very severe penury.

3. The Baptismal Certificate referred to in paragraph 3 of the despatch under reference has been forwarded by Mrs. Evans direct to the Ministry of Pensions.
