I have the honour to tremsmit a form of particulars required for the computation of pension payable to Mr.M.F.Pinto, a I Grade Clerk in the Treasury Department, who has been pronounced unfit for further service in this Colony by a Medical Board held on him in Nairopi on the 16th of August last. A copy of the proceedings of the Medical Board is enclosed for Your Grace's information.

- 2. Mr. Pinto's services date from the 14th April, 1903, and he is, therefore, eligible for a pension in respect of 19 completed years of service the pension is computed at Shs. 2,402/25 per surum, with effect from the 26th November, 1922, inclusive.
- sanction to the pension recommended, I have authorized the grant of an alimentary allowance to Mr. Pinto at the rate of Shs. 2,160/ per annum from the date quoted.
