My Lord Duke,

I have the honour to transmit herewith a Form of Particulars required for the computation of pension payable to Mr. B. Rodrigues, 3rd Grade Clerk in the Treasury Department, who has been retrenched from the service of this Colony.

2. Your Grace will observe that in computing the pension at Shgs. 728/44 per annum Mr. Rodrigues's employment both as a temporary relief Clerk with the 3rd Battalion, King's African Rifles, and subsequently in the Treasury as a charge against Loan funds has been included as pensionable service.

3. A question has however arisen as to whether Mr. Rodrigues's temporary service with the 3rd King's African Rifles from the 16th October, 1912, to 31st March, 1913, may be counted for pension. Mr. Rodrigues's service has been continuous and without break in a clerical capacity and I am of opinion therefore that his case satisfies both the conditions laid down in Mr. Churchill's despatch No. 292 of the 18th February, 1921. I trust that Your Grace will be disposed to accept the views submitted.
