My Lord Duke,

I have the honour to transmit herewith a Form of Particulars required to be furnished in recommending Mr. J.X.Rodrigues, II Grade Clerk, Medical Department, for pension.

2. Mr. Rodrigues has been pronounced unfit for further service in this Colony by a Medical Board held on him in Nairobi on the 20th of December, 1922; a copy of the proceedings is enclosed for Your Grace's information.

3. Mr. Rodrigues' services date from the 27th April, 1905, and he is, therefore, eligible for a pension in respect of eighteen completed years. The pension is computed at Shs.2041-20 a year with effect from the 10th instant inclusive.

4. Pending the receipt of Your Grace's sanction to the pension recommended, I have authorized the grant of an alimentary allowance to Mr. Rodrigues at the rate of Shs.1632/- a year with effect from the date quoted.

INSTRUCTIONS REFERRED TO ON PAGE 1.

If this Paper of Particulars and the Certificates connected with it, be not sent in original, the copies must be duly attested.

HEAD 1.—In the case of an Officer serving on the West Coast of Africa, a statement is to be added whether he is a native of that Coast. (Colonial Regulations, § 430).

HEAD 2.—A statement is to be given of Allowance for which the Applicant is recommended, viz., Superannuation, Gratuity, or Pension, or of any other Allowance, or Gratuity, and its amount. In the case of Pension, the conditions of the Pension in respect of Professional or other special qualifications, the amount, and the date of commencement, a reference should be given to the authority under which the claim is made.

HEAD 3.—If the service has been interrupted by one or more breaks, the word "broken" should be added to the statement of the number of years and months, and the causes, dates, and circumstances of the breaks, should be stated under heading 9.

HEAD 4.—If the Applicant has served in the same Salary, or in the class from which he retires, for a period of 36 months immediately preceding the date of his retirement, the actual annual rate of his Salary, or of the Wages for the 36 months next preceding the date of his retirement, should be stated under heading 10, and the word "average," but if the whole period of service in the same Salary, or in the class from which he retires, should be inserted.

HEAD 5.—If the Applicant has served in the same Salary, or in the class from which he retires, for a period of 36 months immediately preceding the date of his retirement, the actual annual rate of his Salary, or of the Wages for the 36 months next preceding the date of his retirement, should be stated under heading 10, and the word "average," but if the whole period of service in the same Salary, or in the class from which he retires, should be inserted.

HEAD 8.—In cases of infirmity, if the applicant is below the ordinary age for retirement, a Medical Certificate is to be furnished showing that he is disqualified by infirmity of mind or body for discharging his duties of his situation, and that such infirmity is likely to be permanent.

In case of ten years' service or more, this certificate should be signed by two Officers, of whom at least one should, if possible, be a Salaried Officer of the Government.

HEAD 9.—As to "broken" service see HEAD 5.

If the applicant has had any "acting" service, the details must be fully given, with statement whether or not, during the "acting" service, he was connected with the permanent Civil Service of the Colony.

HEAD 11.—If, in special circumstances, a professional Civil Officer has been allowed to have "private practice" without forfeiting his claim to Pension, the facts are to be fully stated.

HEAD 14.—If the Applicant is liable to any deduction from his service under Clause 102 of the Regulations, the facts should be fully stated.

HEAD 19.—The length of service and other particulars of the computation are to be given. When an amount of Salary, &c., is taken, the mode of calculating it (whether by months, &c.) is to be explained.

- 2) Left eye - Native Cataract present. The vision he states has been impaired for about three years.

 Left eye - nil

He complains of occasional headaches.

His heart & other organs show no signs of disease.

The board recommends that Mr. Rodriguez should be invalided from the Service, on account of his defective eyesight unfitting him for his duties as a clerk.
