I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of Your Lordship's despatch No.65 of 12th January enclosing a copy of a letter from Mr. B. Dhishe resarding his treatment by this Government.

Brishe made a similar complaint to Bir Edward Northey in March 1919, and after the matter had been referred to the Magistrate who convicted him it was decided that this was not a case in which Government could intervene. Mr. Shishe appealed against the conviction to the High Court which dismissed the appeal.
