My Lord Duke,

I have the honour to report that during my absence in England the attention of this Government was invited by an Indian Member of Legislative Council to a copy of a newspaper which he had received through the post from Germany entitled "The Vanguard" and described as the "Central Organ of the Communist Party of India (Sec. Communist International).

2. The newspaper is printed by the Emerald Press, Dublin, Ireland, and gives as postal address "P.O. Box 4336, Zurich 13, Switzerland."

3. On the advice of his Executive Council Sir [Name] has authorised the issue of an Order to the Postmaster General under Section 20 of the Indian Post Office Act, 1898, to intercept all copies of the [Name] sent through the Post for delivery at [Name] in Uganda. I enclose in the [Name] a copy of the Order.

4. I am reporting the matter in case the publication has not been brought to Your Grace's notice.

5. A copy of this despatch is being forwarded to the Governor of Uganda.
