I have the honour to enquire whether Your Lordship would cause enquiry to be made regarding Dr. George Madalich, Superintendent of the Sanatorium, Stanborough Park, Watford, Hertfordshire, with a view to ascertaining whether he is individually a suitable person to be in charge of a hospital which the Seventh Day Adventist Mission propose to establish in the South Kavirondo District.

I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of your despatch No. 264 of the 17th of March on the subject of the hospital which the Seventh Day Adventist Mission desire to establish in the South Kavirondo district.

2. I have to refer you to my confidential despatch of the 14th of April on the subject of this Mission's activities in East Africa generally, and to the letter from this Department of the 11th of March to Mr. Campbell as to the particular question of a hospital site. You will no doubt already have arranged for the lease of land for the hospital on receipt of my despatch of the 14th of April.

3. I do not consider that it would be practicable to institute enquiries with respect to Dr. G. Madgwick, but in view of the Mission's general assurances, it must be assumed that he is a suitable person to be placed in charge of the hospital.
