To be 2nd Grade European Police Constable - Constable H. G. Beverton, passing over Constable W. S. Taylor who has not passed his language examination.

2. In consequence of the termination of the appointment of Captain G. S. Cary, Superintendent of Police as referred to in Your Grace's despatch No.501 dated 10th April last the following recommendations are submitted for Your Grace's consideration. The promotions to take effect as from the 21st of December, 1923:-

To be Superintendent of Police - Assistant Superintendent G. Pritchard Brown. The Commissioner of Police is still unable to recommend Captain E. Scott Higgins for promotion.

To be Assistant Superintendent of Police - Assistant Inspector T. R. J. Ridgway, who is recommended above for promotion to Inspector. The Commissioner of Police is of the opinion that the Senior Inspectors are not suitable for promotion.

To be Inspector of Police - Assistant Inspector A. Boy.

To be Assistant Inspector of Police, 1st Grade European Police Constable W. Kerr, D.C.M., passing over Constable Acton who is not recommended.

To be 1st Grade European Police Constable - Constable S. W. Overton, passing over Constables Laing and Tully for the reasons already stated.

To be 2nd Grade European Police Constable - Constable J. H. Walker. The Senior Constables in the 3rd Grade have either not passed the necessary examinations or are not recommended.

3. All the Officers above recommended have passed the necessary

necessary examinations, and I trust Your Grace will approve
of their promotions.
