Clear the line.

28th July Secret Urgent. Your telegram 27th July I have no information here regarding events in Kenya. I have ascertained however from the Eastern Telegraph Company that although the telegraph line between Mombasa and Nairobi is working as usual no Government messages have been received during the past three days for Cable transmission. There is no news otherwise at Mombasa calculated to cause alarm. I am having further enquiries made and will telegraph again later to-day.
