My Lord,

I have the honour to recommend the grant of pensionable status to Mr. Ramji Das, 3rd Grade Assistant in the Laboratories Department with effect from the date of his original engagement in the Protectorate service.

2. Mr. Ramji Das was appointed Compounder with the Medical Department on the 6th May, 1911, and was transferred to the Laboratories Branch on the 1st April, 1915. He was promoted to rank as a 3rd Grade Clerk three years later and is at present drawing salary on the scale of Rs.125/- Rs.7/50 - Rs.155/- per mensem.

3. The Senior Bacteriologist reports that Mr. Ramji Das has performed a considerable amount of good work both for the military and civil authorities and strongly advocates awarding him pension rights as a reward for good service.

4. The Principal Medical Officer endorses the above recommendation and I shall be glad if it can receive favourable consideration.
