Two have provided £18,000 in (?) draft estimates for salaries of above three officers and have also made due provision for clerical staff. Am unaware whether provision made is adequate and suggest that detailed arrangements and possible revision of estimate be left to Superintendent to advise on when he arrives.

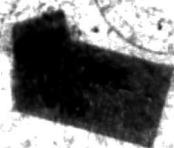
