I have the honour to refer to Your Lordship's telegram of the 9th October last, on the subject of the allocation of funds from the proceeds of land sales and to address you with regard to the inclusion in the annual Protectorate Estimates of the expenditure which it is anticipated will occur in the various localities concerned.

2. I have to state that the plans in connexion with land sales during this year, are indefinite and that there are many possibilities which may prevent the prospective programme from maturing. It follows that it is impossible to forecast with any degree of accuracy the sum likely to be realized at any sale and I agree in the Treasurer's opinion that the principle of inserting provision in the Estimates for capital expenditure which may not come to fruition is open to strong objection on the ground that it is liable to give rise to disappointment and bitter criticism on the part of the community affected.


