My Lord,

I have the honour to refer to Sir Edward Northey's Confidential despatch No. 60 of 10th April last reporting to Your Lordship the circumstances in which the appointment of Mr. F. R. J. Knollys was terminated, and to ask Your Lordship's approval to write off the sum of Rs. 1152/92, which represents the total amount of this person's defalcations, after the deduction of such moneys as were due to him.
