

From the Honourable the Secretary

John Allegany no 219 gave us his opinion -  
holding against the claim of the ex-comittee that  
the Comptroller and Auditor was not  
an independent authority.

(1) I was aware that  
the ex-comittee had a most  
unatisfactory record, but ~~but~~ I had  
no alternative but to agree to his returning to  
the Post as he wished to do this, in view  
of the 2 subsections (2) of the Colonial Business Removal Act  
1887 which read as follows:- "..... a person when discharged  
at the expiration of his sentence shall be entitled to be sent  
frequent to the British possession from which he was removed."

~~and~~ I was advised that, as this Act has been applied to  
the Post as if it were a British possession a clearly unconstitutional  
removal provision may be claimed to be bad and provision in any such  
Instrument under which ~~any~~ might be treated as a qualified discharge  
would ~~be~~ be void for repugnancy to an Act of Parliament affecting its  
His Majesty's subjects in the dominions, ~~that~~ in consequence  
ex-comittee goods ~~as~~ could not be regarded as  
an "import" within the meaning of the Pro-  
tection of exports admissum to the Post as such
