My Lord,

With reference to Paragraph 3 of Your Lordship's despatch No. 516 of 12th June last, regarding the subject of corporal punishment in the East Africa Police, I have the honour to inform Your Lordship that I have caused the Commissioner of Police to furnish a report on this matter.

2. Colonel Wetley states that every case in which the punishment of flogging has been awarded has been reported to him together with full details of the offence and evidence, and that he has, in no case, found it necessary to disagree with the punishment awarded.

3. I am fully satisfied that the sentences are being awarded with very careful discrimination and in accordance with the intention of the


