I regret the delay in replying to the points raised in the Colonial Office despatch but it has been caused through the necessity of frequent references to and from Civil Administration Ser-ge-Salson and shortage and continual change of staff at the Chief Registrar's Office.

I will deal with the War Office observations as follows:

1. Guam and Enemy Territory

This matter is still under consideration between the Chief Registrar, S.A.P.C and Treasurer Ser-ge-Salson. As far as can be ascertained at present the necessary adjustments were all effected in 1918/19 with a 1% of my 1918/19 report on military accounts.

2. Madia Island

This is dealt with in a 12% of the report of the Acting Director of Military Audit, for the year 1917/18.

3. Prisoners of War

For reasons stated in para 113 and enclosures hereto of the audit report on the Military Accounts for year 1918/19 it is desirable to have the full information required. The Chief Registrar has, however, prepared a schedule, copy enclosed, of all payments to officers, privates and other men of naval and military affairs here locally. I also enclose a further copy of the statement also submitted with my 1917/18 report, showing the signature on Prisoners of War under the year 1918/19.
