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My Lord,

I have the honour to forward herewith a form of particulars required for the computation of a pension to Mr. H.K. Smith, a 2nd Grade Clerk in the Treasury, who has been pronounced unfit for further service in this Protectorate by a Medical Board held on him in India.

2. Mr. Smith's service dates from December 1906 and he is eligible therefore, for a pension in respect of 13 completed years. This pension is granted at £26-17-4 per annum with effect from 13th April 1920.

3. Although the report of the Medical Board which invalidated this official is dated 1st June, I would recommend that the pension be antedated to 13th April so as to cover the period of leave without pay. This is in accordance with the precedent approved by Your Lordship in despatch No. 429 of the 20th May 1919.

## INSTRUCTIONS REFERRED TO ON PAGE 1.

**If this Paper of Particulars and the Certificates connected with it, be not sent in original, the copies must be duly attested**

**HEAD 10**—In the case of an Officer serving on the West Coast of Africa, a statement is to be made whether he is a native of that Coast. (Colonial Regulations, § 430.)

**HEAD 11**—State the description of Allowance for which the Applicant is recommended, viz. Superannuation, Compensation, Compassionate Allowance, Gratuity, and its amount. In the case of a claimant in addition to their Pension, in respect of Professional or other special qualifications, should be stated, and a reference should be given to the authority under which the claim is made.

**HEAD 12**—If the Applicant has been interrupted by one or more breaks, the word "broken" should be placed before or after the number of years and months, and the causes, dates, and circumstances of the breaks should be stated under heading 9.

**HEAD 13**—If the Applicant has received in receipt of the same Salary, or in the class from which he retires, for the 36 months immediately before the date of his retirement, the actual amount of Salary or Wages for that date should be inserted, preceded by the word "actual." In cases where the average annual amount of Salary or Wages for the 36 months preceding the retirement shall be inserted, preceded by the word "average." If the Applicant has served for less than three years, then the average for the whole period should be inserted.

the ordinary age for retirement, a Medical Certificate should be furnished by a physician of mind or body for disability, such infirmity is likely to be permanent.

If the Applicant is recommended for service or more, this Certificate should be signed by two Officers, one of whom should, if possible, be a Senior Officer of the Government.

**HEAD 15**—If the Applicant has been in "acting" service, see HEAD 10.

If the Applicant has had any "acting" service, the details must be fully given with a statement whether or not, during the "acting" service, he was connected with the permanent Civil Service of the Colony.

**HEAD 16**—If, in special circumstances, a professional Civil Officer has been allowed to take "private" practice without forfeiting his claimed Pension, the facts are to be fully stated.

**HEAD 17**—If the Applicant is liable to any deduction from his service under Chapter 10 of the Colonial Regulations, the facts should be fully stated.

**HEAD 18**—The length of service and other particulars of the compensation are to be given. When an average Salary is shown, the mode of calculating it is to be given, and the date of the retirement is to be stated.
