With reference to Sir Charles Bowring's despatch No. 1146 of the 21st November on the subject of the water supply at Afwadi, Jubaland, I have the honour to inform Your Lordship that the drilling outfit, mentioned in "Report" was examined by a board of enquiry on 26th May. Boring started the first part of the plant was found to be in good condition but it was evident that it was not well balanced.

In consequence of the uncertainty of the climate especially in Jubaland it is understood that no further expedition will be sent. In the meantime an attempt is being made to install a ship's pump temporarily with a trough so as to obviate the necessity for the constant employment of natives on raising the water from the wells by hand.
