With reference to Sir Charles Boring's despatch No. 1146 of the 21st November on the subject of the water supply at Afmahu, Jubaland, I have the honour to inform Your Lordship that the drilling outfit, etc., mentioned in the despatch were examined by a party of the Government Boring party and the results of the examination were such that it was considered that it was advisable to proceed with the work.

3. In consequence of the uncertainty as to the disposal of Jubaland it is undesirable to incur further expenditure at present. In the meantime an attempt is being made to install a ship's pump temporarily with a trough so as to obviate the necessity for the constant employment of natives on raising the water from the wells by hand.
