With reference to Your Lordship's Confidential despatch of 29th June, I have the honour to inform Your Lordship that I consider that ample time has now been allowed for public criticism and comment on the proposed Removal of Undesirables Ordinance, and that I have accordingly given instructions that the bill should be introduced at the next session of the Legislative Council.

2. As Your Lordship was informed in the Acting Governor's Confidential despatch No. 34 of 16th February the passing of bill was delayed in order to allow any such comment to be made, since its provisions were held to be of a controversial nature, steps being taken to publish the terms of the bill for general information.

3. In notifying Your Lordship of my decision I would reiterate the assertion made in the Acting
