Liability under "Suspense Sundry Accounts" in the Annual Statement of Assets and Liabilities.

6. The irrecoverable portion is obviously no asset and of the remainder such amount as may eventually be recovered should be treated as revenue in the year of receipt and ~~not~~ as a ~~settling~~ asset.

7. The position of the Suspense Account as at March 31st last was approximately:-

8. In view of the foregoing I would suggest that the authority of the Secretary of State may be obtained to close the account and write off the balance of approximately Rs. 335440-35 cents.

9. It should be stated in explanation:-

(a) That the irrecoverable amount of Rs. 132270-70 is reported by the Ag. Director of Surveys to be in respect of unremunerative surveys given as the sub-division of fees for the ex-Soldier Settlement Scheme and laying out Government Reserves, Outpans, etc.

(b) That satisfactory records are in course of compilation by the Ag. Director of Surveys of the survey fees on lands surveyed at the cost of approximately Rs. 203160-60 so that all amounts that may eventually become recoverable will be claimed.

10. As regards the current and future years provision should be made for "Fees of Licensed Surveyors" under a new sub-head of Schedule XVII Land Department, Other Charges, Item 98, and all survey fees

on sales of land whether surveyed by Government or licensed Surveyors should be brought to account under Schedule IV Pacts of Survey etc. Item 3 Survey Fees.

11. The M.D. Director of Surveys estimates the expenditure for the current year at Rs. 44000 and I enclose a special warrant for drawing of His Excellency's allowance to cover this amount.

12. As the Revenue M.D. Director of Surveys now estimates the total receipts from Survey Fees at. as:-

13. This reduction in revenue is attributed to the extension of the period during which individual settlers may pay the survey fees, &c., on their farms. I propose to submit the figures when the revised estimates for the current year are submitted.
