As Uganda will not agree no increase imposed. Cannot increase rates against Kenya producers and net Uganda. Only course is to retain present surcharge. Cannot find revenue from any other source this year. Suggests deficit estd £150,000 be made up from loan. Principle is bad but future debt will justify. Avoidance increase rates will be greatest relief to producers. Had it not been for £800,000 direct charge on account war expenses present position would not exist.

Your telegram 7th August. Railway rates as Governor of Uganda will not agree no increase has been imposed. I cannot increase rates against Kenya producers and not Uganda. Only course now open is retention of present surcharge. I cannot find required revenue from any other source this year therefore suggest only alternative deficit on financial year estimated at £150,000 be made up from loan. I admit principle is bad but am confident future development of resources will justify. Losses on exchange and high freights have hit producers so hard this year that avoidance of increase of railway freights will be greatest relief. Up to March last Kenya had borne £800,000 as direct charge against revenue for Protectorate share war expenses. Had it not been for this present financial position would not exist.
