502 September 7th Your despatch 21st June 859 Indian postal clerks and telegraphists see remarks page two my despatch 13th August 891. Caine cables from India that impossible to recruit satisfactory telegraphists conditions imposed. Under Lascelles scheme married clerks recruited at Rs. 120 per month actually drew Rs. 214 total emoluments whereas under revised scheme your despatch 17th June confidential clerks recruited at a maximum of 3rd grade plus 15% house allowance draw only 207 rupees. Consider that maximum 3rd grade the minimum at which we can recruit satisfactory trained telegraphists from India accordingly requests sanction to engage reduced number of twenty at this rate. These would meet immediate urgent requirements.
