I beg to inform you that Lieut. Hamilton Moore, M.L.C., has been awarded, upon the recommendation of the local Imperial Pensions Board and subject to confirmation by the East African Government, a pension of 252-10/- per annum for the period 10/4/19 to 31/10/19 conditional, less the period he was in hospital, viz 17/4/19 to 15/5/19 for which he was paid hospital allowance.

In addition to the above award, Mr Moore is still due hospital allowance at the rate of 2175 per annum for the period 14-15/5/19, less 4/6d per diem hospital charges.

I shall be glad therefore, if you will arrange for payment in accordance with the above award and recover from the East African Government through the Agents for the Crown Colonies.
