My Lord,

With reference to Your Lordship's despatch No.1017 of 20th July, I have the honour to inform Your Lordship that, after careful consideration and discussion with my Executive Council, I have decided on the following steps in regard to the conditions of the Ex-Soldier Settlement Scheme and to the allenation of Crewn Lands generally.

- 2. As regards the provisions of the Discharged Soldiers Settlement Ordinance, 1919, I have determined that no extension shall be made beyond July 14th of this year.
- 3. In view of the rate of exchange and its adverse effect on the importation of capital from abroad, I have approved the reduction of the purchase price of all farms under the Ex-Soldier Settlement Scheme by 333 per cent. I have also decided that where individual mistakes of valuation have occurred, i.e. discrepancies of valuation of one
