My Lord,

I have the honour to report that subject to Your Lordship's covering sanction I have approved the appointment of Sheikh Ali bin Salim, C.M.G., C.B.E., Assistant Liwali of Mombasa, to be Liwali of Mombasa, in succession to his father the late Sheikh Ali bin Khalifa, C.M.G., who died on the 10th of July.

2. There has been an interval allowed for the succession in deference to Mohammedan sentiment and Sheikh Ali bin Salim's appointment has been gazetted with effect from the 1st September, 1920.
