Sir,

With reference to your letter Gov/4698/1919 - 20 of the 3rd February, and subsequent reminder concerning the grant of a permanent pension to Mr. F.J. Ducrotoy, late Trooper East Africa, Mounted Rifles, I am directed by the Minister of Pensions to inform you that had Mr. Ducrotoy been serving with the Imperial Forces at the time he was wounded, he would have been awarded a pension of 11/- a week from 25th October 1918 to 2nd September 1919, then 16/- a week from 3rd September 1919 to 24th October 1919 conditional then 15/- Permanent from 25th October 1919. Allowances for children provided they had been eligible under the provisions of Article 24(3) of the Royal Warrant would have been at the following rate, 9/8 for 5 to 2nd September 1919 then 14/8 from 3rd September 1919.
