With reference to your letter, No. 2495/20, of the
10th June, concerning the proposal to repeal Section 25 of
the Uganda Savings Bank Ordinance No. 4 of 1907, I am
directed by the Postmaster General to acquaint you, for the
information of the Secretary of State for the Colonies,
that amounts standing to the credit of depositors in the
Post Office Savings Bank in this Country may be withdrawn by
the depositors or their legal representatives, no matter what
period has elapsed since the last previous transaction took
place in connexion with the relative accounts. This
arrangement is found to work satisfactorily, and the
Postmaster General suggests the adoption of similar
arrangements in connexion with Post Office Savings Bank

Accounts in Uganda, the East African Protectorate, and Nyasaland. He agrees that Section 26 as well as Section 25 of the Uganda Savings Bank Ordinance should be repealed, and recommends the repeal of Sections 24 and 25 of the East African Savings Bank Ordinance No. 5 of 1909 and of Section 4 of the Nyasaland Savings Bank Ordinance No. 10 of 1910. In this connexion, the Secretary of State may be interested to refer to the evidence given by the Controller of the Post Office Savings Bank before the Select Committee of the House of Commons on the Dormant Bank Balances and Unclaimed Securities Bill (see pages 77-82 of H.C. 233 of 1930).

The Postmaster General will be glad to learn in due course what measures Lord Milner has seen fit to take in the matter.
