Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 13th August, No. 38826/20, I am directed to inform you that, apant from what is stated to below, no war bonus (or similar temporary addition to make has been granted to civil officers coming from India to this country on leave.

Civil Officers on leave are, as regards leave allowances under either the European Services Leave Rules or the Indian Services Leave Rules. Broadly speaking, officers under both sets of rules are, if on ordinary furlough, entitled to half average salary subject to certain sterling maxima and minima. For furlough other than ordinary, quarter average salary only is, in some cases, admissible, subject also to certain sterling maxima and minima.

In view of the rise in prices in this country withe above mentioned sterling maxima and minima have been recently increased. The enclosed circulars show the increases in the case of

- (1) Members of the Indian Civil Service.
- (2) Other officers under the European Services
- (3) Officers under the Indian Services Leave Rules.

It should be explained that, under a recent decision, officers on leave on half average salary have been allowed, subject to certain conditions, to commute a portion of their furlowsh

If paid in India, Rs. 1,000 a month, instead of Rs. 888, a month

If paid in England, £60 a month (instead of £480 a year), or one-fourth of age salary, whichever is less.

If paid in India, Rs. 600 a month (instead of Rs. 533), a month, or one-fourthdaniage salary, whichever is less.

Resolution improvement of the fiests of officers subject to European and Indian Service

Having considered the resonmendations in the Rece. of the Royal commission in the Public Services in India for the improvement of the leave sules of officers subject to the European and the Indian service leave rules, the timestant of India are pleased, with the approval of the Secretary of State, to substitute the following rules:—

(e) The officer's average salary, if paid at the Hone Treasury of the Government of India or in a Cotony where the standard of currency is gold, will be converted into sterling

(f) Privilege leave to the extent due may be prefixed to furlough on average salary, subject to a maximum2 of eight months for the two kinds of leave combined, on each occasion of such combination.

(q) Furlough on half average salary may be granted in continuation of furlough on average salary or of combined

privilege leave and furlough on average salary.

- (3) Article 264 and Note 2 to Article 826 of the Civil Service Regulations will be cancelled, and all officers will be permitted to take privilege leave or furlough on average salary or both combinpreparatory to retirement. Similarly, officers who have passed the age of superannuation will be allowed to take privilege leavpreparatory to retirement.
- These orders will take effect from 18th November 1919, the date of issue of the Secretary of State's sanction, and officers who were on furlough or combined leave on that date may be permitted to commute into furlowsh on average salary the furlough portion of the leave which they were the enjoying.
- 3. The concession sauctioned for officers subject to the European servaleave rules in chause (2) of paragraph I above will be extended to gazette t officers who come under the Indian service leave rules on conditions who will be announced as soon as possible
- 4. The necessary additions and corrections to the Civil Service Regu lations will be issued in due course
