BRITISH EAST AFRICA (NATIVE
LABOUR AND TAXATION).

Mr. SPOOR asked the Under Secretary
of State for the Colonies whether his
attention has been drawn to the sugges-
tion that taxation should be varied in
British East Africa according to the capa-
bility of natives to labour for settlers; and
whether he will inform Sir Edward
Northey that His Majesty's Government
is not prepared to permit taxation imposed
with the object of forcing labour in the
interests of a particular class?

Lieut.-Colonel AMERY: The whole
question of native labour and taxation is
receiving careful consideration and will
be further discussed with Sir E. Northey
by the Secretary of State on his return.
