

Healy of the Survey Department is due to proceed to England in July next on termination of his engagement, and that on the recommendation of the Director of Surveys, I propose, subject to your approval, to sanction the appointment of 2nd Corporal M. Thornton to file In vacancy caused by his departure.

- 2. I would also ask, if my action meets with your approval, that you would approach the War Office with a view to obtaining a new Non-Som-missioned Officer or Sapper with a good knowledge of plane-tabling.
- 3. His salary would be £215 per annum plus £36 house allowance, and his engagement, which should date from January 19th 1913, would be for a period of three years, including six months leave to England, with free pagages.
- 4. In this connection the Director of Euryeys has mentioned the name of Lance Corporal A.K.
  Turner, Royal Engineers, who was formerly employed in Nicola, or failing him, either Sapper W.
