
I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of your despatch No. 241 of the 27th April, and, in reply, to inform you that licenses are issued to surveyors in this Protectorate under the following conditions.

2. On payment of a fee of Rs. 75 a license to survey is issued to any surveyor holding a Survey license (or survey diploma) granted by any of the self-governing Dominions or Colonies; or to any other person of good repute who, after having served satisfactorily for 2 years in the field under a Licensed Surveyor, afterwards passes an examination held by the Director of Surveys, such examination being similar to those insisted on by the self-governing Dominions or Colonies.
