With reference to previous correspondence on the subject of the works contemplated at Kilindini, I have the honour to confirm my telegram of the 17th instant which read as follows:-

~~"Our despatch No. 678 of September 28th..... have thoroughly discussed with Sandiford, Church and Gailey proposals for improvement of Kilindini Wharf accommodation and strongly support them. Request that Crown Agents be instructed to expedite indents sent. Please telegraph if you support scheme so that I can proceed meanwhile with erection of new baggage room.~~

I am satisfied that these improvements will fit in with any future wharf extensions connected with deep water pier. In regard to ~~latter hope to receive statement from Gailey~~ by end of November."
