The Bill for this Ordinance modelled on the Uganda Official Secrets Ordinance 1912 was introduced on the instructions of the Secretary of State and has been passed by the Council without any alteration.

Except for the substitution of "Attorney General" for "Crown Advocate" in Section B, this Ordinance is in the terms of the Uganda Ordinance.

The Ordinance may be assented to and published forthwith.
