Sir,

With reference to your despatch No. 179 of April 2nd, I have the honour to report that I have sanctioned the expenditure from general savings of £4,400 for the Merhan Patrol and £1,400 for the Masai Move during the current financial year.

2. Two motions, copies of which are attached, were introduced at the last meeting of the Legislative Council, resolving that the sums above mentioned should be expended, and were agreed to.

3. Sanction to meet the cost of the Merhan Patrol from general savings was received in your telegram of the 25th ultimo and subsequently confirmed in your Confidential despatch of the 27th ultimo.

4. In Mr. Bowring's despatch No. 635 of the 14th September sanction was sought to expend the sum of £1,400 in connection with the Masai Move out of general savings. The salaries of the two Veterinary Officers approved in your despatch No. 536 of the 23rd August are included in this amount.
