Sir,

I have the honour to report that I have accepted the resignation of Abdulla bin Salim. employee of the Customs Department.

2. This man was engaged in the days of the Imperial British East Africa Company and was subsequently transferred to the service of the Crown. He has therefore completed 17 continuous years under the Government. In an engagement with the Wakamba at Machakos some 18 years ago he received a wound which necessitated the amputation of one of his legs. He is now practically a pensioner and unfit for work.
