

LEGAL REPORT.

THE COMMISSIONS OF INQUIRY ORDINANCE, 1912.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to confer powers upon the Governor to appoint Commissions of Inquiry and to empower Commissioners so appointed to compel the attendance of witnesses and to take evidence on oath.

There is, at present, no local Ordinance dealing with such matters.

The Ordinance is based on laws which have been approved for enactment for the Crown Colonies on the West Coast of Africa.

In my opinion the Ordinance is one which may be assented to by His Excellency forthwith.
