No objection to experiments in recruitment of Somalis on conditions specified. No necessity to amplify by despatch.

The S. P. had this telegram before today's deputation came, and read it to them.

How? send Mr. Davell a copy - omitting last sentence - & also a copy of our tel. of the 14th - say that it is presumed that the Gov's stipulations will be accepted, & that we will inf. C. Somaliland by the next mail so that he can consider the form of contract & other arrangements with their representatives when he arrives. We might add that the S. P. will require to be assured that the accommodation will be ready before the labourers arrive.

Despatches can be drafted when all the papers are available.

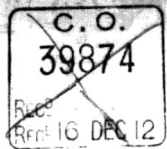

No objection to No. 216. Your telegram 14th December, experiments in recruitment of Somalis, always provided that annual contract imposes on employers obligation to provide adequate and suitable food and house accommodation for labourers and dependents free of cost to labourer, and to repatriate if requested by labourer or Government at end of annual term or any extension of engagement. Requirements of labourers should be stated by Commissioner of Somaliland and contract settled in accordance with such requirements.
