The following additions to the pensionable establishment appear to have been made in the East Africa Protectorate during 1911-12 with the approval of the Secretary of State.

Mr: A.Walker - salary £160, on scale of £120 by £10 to £180. See E.A.P. 3560.

Mr: H.E.Dean - salary £190, rising by £20 per annum to £280. See E.A.P. 3917.

There appears to be no evidence in the papers that the specific sanction of the Treasury, required under Rule 59(iii) of the Colonial Audit Department Regulations, has been applied for. Will you please inform me whether it has now been obtained in these instances.
