Sir,

I have laid before the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury Sir G. Fiddes' letter of the 13th ultimo relative to the scale of salary of Assistant Auditors in the East Africa Protectorate.

In reply I am to state that, in the circumstances represented by Mr. Secretary Harcourt, My Lords while regretting that Their previous authority was not obtained in ordinary course, give Their covering approval for the payment as from the 1st April last of the Assistant Auditors on the scale of £300 - £10 - £400 as proposed by the Director of Colonial Audit.

This authority, however, is given on the understanding that the concession now made will not be regarded as a precedent for improving the position of Clerks in other Departments of the Protectorate.
