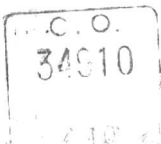

Sir,

I am directed to state for the information of the Secretary of State for the Colonies that the Government of India have approved a proposed visit of His Highness the Maharaja of Datta, a State in Central India, to British East Africa and Uganda, for a few months.

I am to explain that the conduct of the Maharaja led the Government of India in 1911 to relieve him of his ruling powers, and he has since resided at a distance from his State. The Secretary of State is informed that a change of scene is most desirable for him and will be beneficial physically and morally. He will travel as a private person, accompanied by his guardian, Captain Tyndall, a medical officer, one State Sardar and a few servants. The party sails from India on the 31st October.

I am to request that, if there is no objection, the above information may be communicated for the guidance of the local authorities concerned.
